

Admittance Policy

1. All horses shall be admitted according to their number on the waiting list providing they meet the stated requirements.
2. A horse may be deferred for a period of one, two or three years, up to two times. If the owner declines a 3rd time he/she will be either removed from the list or placed at the end of the list.
3. At the time of admittance to Ryerss Farm, ownership of the horse is transferred to Ryerss Farm. Ryerss Farm becomes the sole owner and care provider. The former owner relinquishes all rights to said horse and the horse shall remain at Ryerss Farm until it expires.
4. A horse may be placed on the list at any age.
5.
 - a. A horse/horses under agreement such as a will where Ryerss will be amply compensated, or any such document amply compensating Ryerss shall be admitted immediately, providing horse/horses would be in untenable situations.
 - b. If a horse is in a rescue situation by an S.P.C.A., or Large Animal Protection Society or similar authority, Ryerss will make every effort to accommodate said horse/horses.
6. Once a horse is admitted to the farm, the horse stays on the farm for the rest of its life.
